Vaccination Centre – Access Information

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<p>Where is this vaccination centre?</p>	<p>Musselburgh Vaccination Centre is located inside Musselburgh Primary Care Centre.</p> <p>The address is:</p> <p>Musselburgh Primary Care Centre Inveresk Road Musselburgh EH21 7BP</p>
<p>How do I find this vaccination centre?</p>	<p>The clinic is on the ground floor and is close to the main entrance, on the right-hand side as you enter the building.</p>
<p>How can I get to this vaccination centre?</p>	<p>The clinic can be accessed by walking or wheeling via Inveresk Road.</p> <p>The closest national cycle route is Route 76.</p> <p>The clinics can be reached using the following bus services:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lothian Buses – 140 and 141 (direct to Inveresk Road) and 30, X26, 26, 44, 106, 113 and 124 – all under a 10-minute journey from the front entrance using High Street or Bridge Street stops. • Prentice Buses: 108, 111 and 118

	<p>If driving, follow the signs to Musselburgh. The clinic is signposted from the road with yellow road signs from all approaches.</p>
<p>Is there a quiet room or private space?</p>	<p>Yes, there is a private space that can be used for vaccination. Please speak to the receptionist when you arrive.</p> <p>You do not need to arrange this in advance of your visit, we will accommodate you however we can.</p>
<p>Is this vaccination site wheelchair accessible?</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
<p>What toilet facilities are available?</p>	<p>Accessible toilets are located on the ground floor, just next to the vaccination clinic.</p>
<p>Are there hearing loops in use?</p>	<p>There are no hearing loops at this Vaccination Centre.</p>
<p>Are assistance dogs welcome?</p>	<p>Assistance dogs are welcome at every Vaccination Centre. If you need any additional support, please speak to a member of staff who will be happy to help.</p>
<p>What are the parking arrangements?</p>	<p>Bike parking is at the main entrance to the building. If this is full, there is additional covered bike parking to the right-side of the car park as you look at the building.</p> <p>The nearest car park is on site, including spaces reserved for those with disabilities. Parking in this area is limited.</p> <p>There is a large car park at the Tesco supermarket nearby, but please be advised that the length of time you can park in supermarket car parks is usually limited.</p>
<p>Can I attend my appointment at this site with a friend, family member or carer?</p>	<p>Yes. You are welcome to bring a friend, family member or carer with you but we do ask this is limited to one person, where possible.</p> <p>Parents and carers are welcome to bring children along with them.</p>
<p>Are there interpretation services?</p>	<p>Yes, all clinics can provide telephone interpretation services. Please let the vaccinator or a member of the team know which language you require.</p>

	<p>For verbal interpretation, a call will be made to The Big Word service where you and your vaccinator will be connected to an interpreter.</p> <p>You do not need to arrange this in advance of your visit.</p>
<p>Can I arrange a BSL interpreter for an appointment?</p>	<p>Yes, please call the Vaccination Enquiries Helpline before your visit on 0300 790 6296 or email loth.vaccenquiries@nhslothian.scot.nhs.uk to request the assistance of a BSL interpreter. A member of the Translation and Interpretation Team will help to arrange this for you. This needs to be pre-arranged before your appointment.</p>
<p>Are the doors automatic?</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
<p>Can I arrange the assistance of a sighted guide?</p>	<p>Yes, please call the Vaccination Enquiries Helpline before your visit on 0300 790 6296 or email loth.vaccenquiries@nhslothian.scot.nhs.uk to request the assistance of a sighted guide.</p> <p>A member of the Translation and Interpretation Team will help to arrange this for you.</p>
