Vaccination Centre – Access Information

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Where is this vaccination centre?	Newbyres Medical Practice 15 Hunterfield Road Gorebridge Midlothian EH234TP
How do I find this vaccination centre?	Main entrance is signposted from road, behind ICR Vets. Site has public parking facilities.
How can I get to this vaccination centre?	One-way entrance and exit via car. Follow signs for Newbyres Medical Practice. Located adjacent to the main road in Gorebridge. Short walk from bus stop servicing Lothian Buses route 48 and 29.
Is there a quiet room or private space?	Yes, a private treatment room is utilised for vaccinations.
Is this vaccination site wheelchair accessible?	Yes – caution is advised in the car park as it is in poor condition with several potholes. There is a steep slope downwards to main entrance. Healthcare facilities are all on the ground floor.

What toilet facilities are available?	Accessible and public toilets are both behind a key-safe locked door, patients must ask for access via reception.
Are there hearing loops in use?	Yes
Are assistance dogs welcome?	Yes, assistance dogs are welcome in every vaccination centre
What are the parking arrangements?	Limited parking available due to being a public car park with several sites utilising this. Bike racks available next to attached pharmacy on site.
Can I attend my appointment at this site with a friend, family member or carer?	Yes, but we ask if this can be limited to one person where possible. Parents and carers are welcome to bring children along with them.
Are there interpretation services?	Yes. All clinics can provide telephone interpretation services via The Big Word. This does not require advance arrangements.
Can I arrange a BSL interpreter for an appointment?	Yes, please call the Vaccination Enquiries Helpline before your visit on 0300 790 6296 or email loth.vaccenquiries@nhs.scot to pre-arrange the services of a BSL interpreter. A member of the Translation and Interpretation Team will help arrange this.
Are the doors automatic?	Yes
